A Word about the Montessori 5 day Program

Tuition above is based on a five day per week program. Five days a week of classroom attendance is what is best for all Montessori students. Young children thrive on routine and consistency of a set schedule. Children experience a strong sense of belonging when attending school the same number of days as their classmates. Opting for fewer days WILL mean your child will miss group lessons and special interest presentations. In rare instances, we will consider a program for 3 days and 4 days per week, but please know in advance, these are not ideal for any Montessori child.

Scholarships Available to Families that Qualify

Upon occasion, HDMS receives a donation earmarked specifically for scholarships to families who are unable to send their child to a Montessori School at full tuition. If you want your child to receive a top notch Montessori education but think you might not be able to afford full tuition, please inquire about available scholarships.

Program Offerings

New Student Orientation Camp

All new students are required to attend Orientation Camp. During this time, students learn ground rules for the classroom as well as develop routines.

Early Arrival Program

Families wishing to bring children before the start of class must register for before-school care and may drop their child off as early as 8:00 am. Please park in the school lot and walk your child around to the patio doors for admittance into the building.

Last-Year Program

This valuable program allows our oldest Primary students to explore the concrete advanced Primary materials as well as delve into the abstract “crossover” materials designed for students entering the Lower Elementary Classrooms of Montessori Schools the world over. Last Year students step confidently into leadership and mentorship by assisting the classroom guide with the presentation of materials to younger students. They also have an integral role in maintaining the classroom environment. They are the “leaders” of the classroom. All “Last Years” attend school five days a week from 8:40 am to 2:30 pm.

Full-Day Program

Families wishing for a longer school day, may pick students up at 2:30 pm. During full day, students eat lunch, rest or nap, assist in caring for classrooms and participate in enrichment activities such as art, music, Spanish, children’s yoga, etc.

Extended Day Program (Afterschool)

Families desiring a longer school day experience, may pick students up as late as 5:45 pm. During these last few hours of the day, students eat snack, engage in an afternoon work cycle and play outdoors or in our indoor play room. Please text the school when you are 10 minutes out so staff can assist your child in preparing to leave school. Parents of afterschool students are asked to park in the lot and walk down the side drive to the patio for dismissal.
